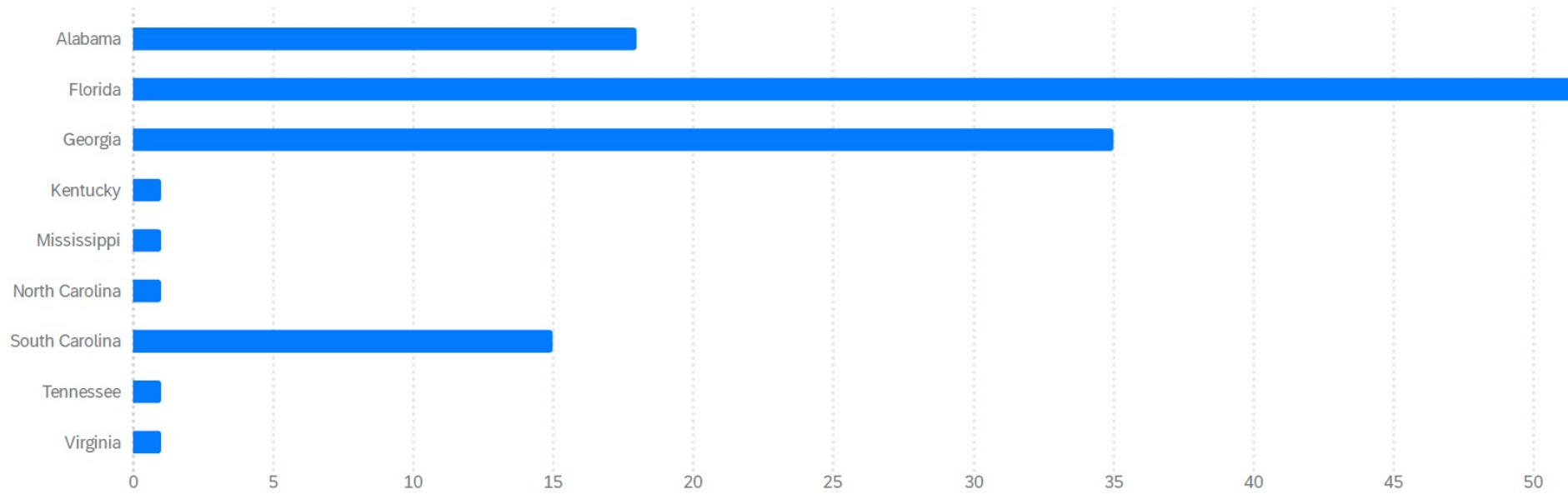

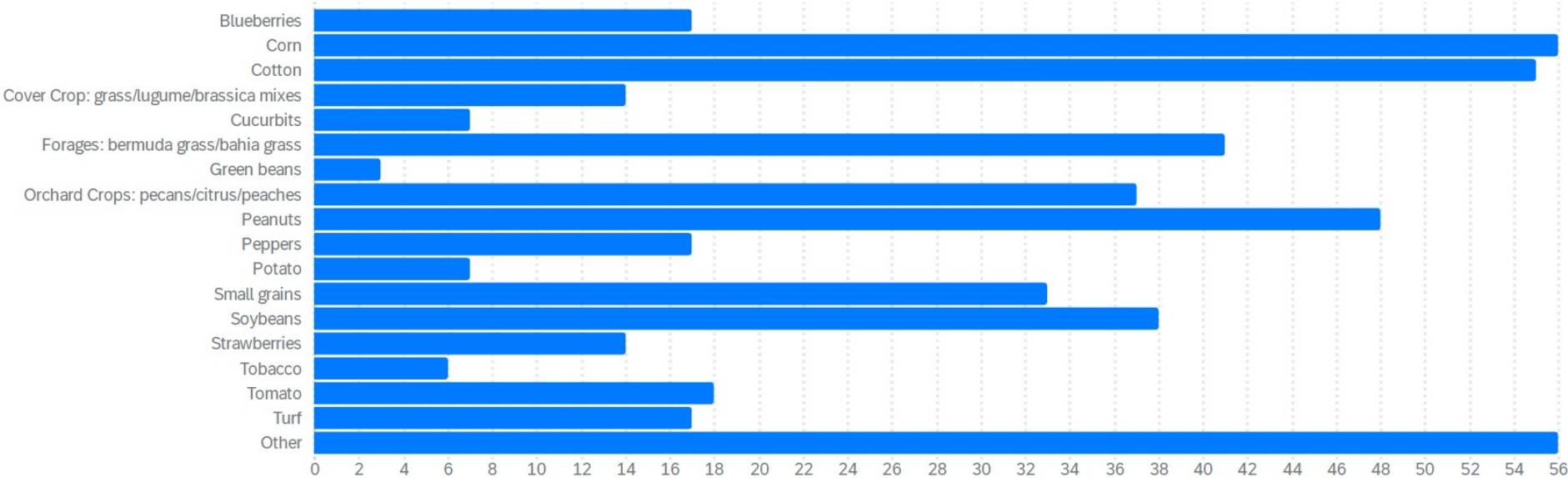

### What state(s) do you advise in?



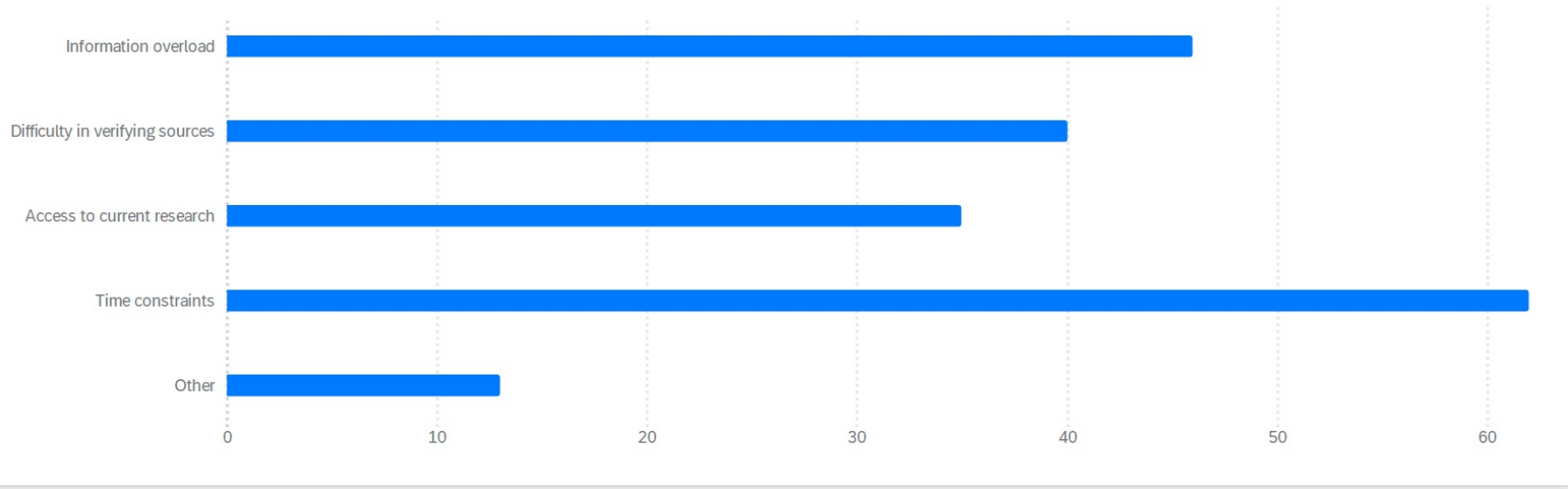


What crops do you currently advise clients on?



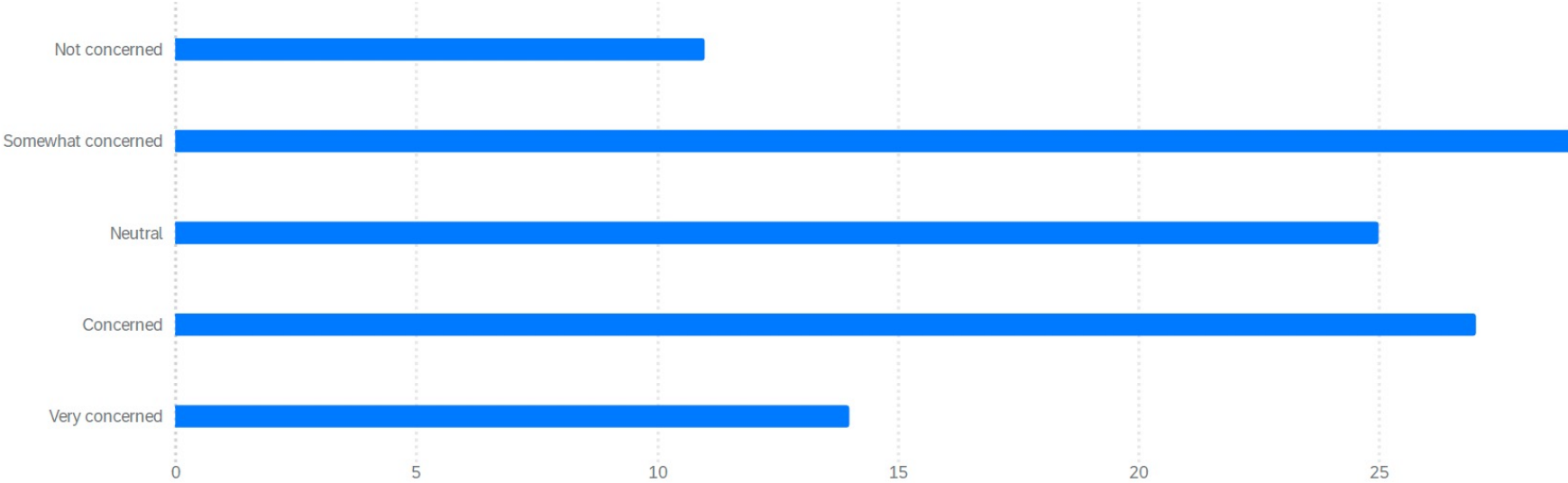


The challenges I face as a crop advisor when seeking out new and reliable information to advise my clients on crop managements and BMPs are:



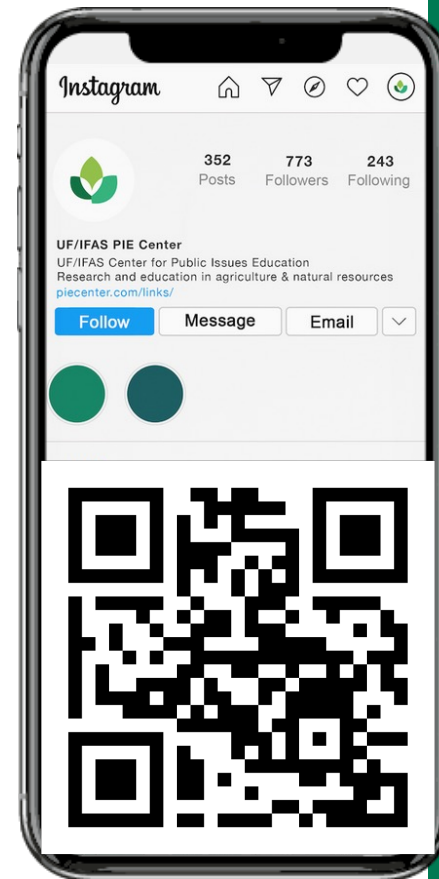


How concerned are you about the accuracy and reliability of soil test results used in nutrient management recommendations?
